Care Compare January Refresh of SNF QRP Data – Now Available

The January 2022 refresh of the Skilled Nursing Facility (SNF) Quality Reporting Program (QRP) data is now available on [Care Compare](#) and [Provider Data Catalog \(PDC\)](#).

The data are based on quality assessment data submitted by SNFs to Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) from **Quarter 3, 2020 through Quarter 1, 2021 (3 quarters)**. The data for the claims-based measures will continue to display **Quarter 4, 2017 through Quarter 3, 2019** data for this refresh while CMS performs additional measure analyses.
