Medicare and Medicaid Notice to Public

Notice is hereby given that on February 18, 2022, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) will terminate the agreement between the Secretary of Health and Human Services and QHC Mitchellville, Mitchellville, Iowa as a skilled nursing facility in the Medicare program. In addition, as authorized by the Iowa Department of Inspections and Appeals, notice is given that the provider's agreement as a nursing facility in the Medicaid program will also be terminated effective February 18, 2022. These actions are taken because CMS has determined that QHC Mitchellville failed to attain substantial compliance with certain Medicare and Medicaid participation requirements. If the provider demonstrates substantial compliance with all CMS requirements, and a revisit survey confirms substantial compliance, prior to February 18, 2022, the provider will remain active in the Medicare Program and CMS will not terminate their provider agreement.

In addition, Federal Financial Participation will not be available to the State for any Medicaid residents admitted to the facility on or after September 16, 2021. For Medicaid residents admitted prior to September 16, 2021, Federal Financial Participation may continue to be made to the State for up to 30 days of covered services to qualified residents furnished on or after February 18, 2022, the date of termination.
