**Medicare and Medicaid Notice to the Public**

Notice is hereby given that on May 22, 2023, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) will terminate the agreement between the Secretary of Health and Human Services and Royal Oak Nursing & Rehab, St. Louis, Missouri as a skilled nursing facility in the Medicare program. In addition, as authorized by the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services notice is given that the provider's agreement as a nursing facility in the Medicaid program will also be terminated effective May 22, 2023. These actions are taken because CMS has determined that Royal Oak Nursing & Rehab failed to attain substantial compliance with certain Medicare and Medicaid participation requirements as mandated by Sections 1819(h)(2)(C) of the Social Security Act and Federal regulations at 42 CFR §488.412 and 488.456). If the provider demonstrates substantial compliance with all CMS requirements, and a revisit survey confirms substantial compliance, prior to May 22, 2023, the provider will remain active in the Medicare Program and CMS will not terminate their provider agreement.

Federal Financial Participation will not be available to the State for any Medicaid residents admitted to the facility on or after January 3, 2023. For Medicaid residents admitted prior to January 3, 2023, Federal Financial Participation may continue to be made to the State for up to 30 days of covered services to qualified residents furnished on or after May 22, 2023, the date of termination.
