If your income for 2023 is below \$22,000 (\$30,000 for married couples), you may qualify for lower prescription drug costs. Many people qualify for “Extra Help” with Medicare Part D (drug coverage) and don’t even know it. It could pay to find out: www.medicare.gov/ExtraHelp

#DYK with “Extra Help,” you can cut your Medicare Part D (drug coverage) premium to \$0 and greatly reduce your prescription drug copayments? See if you’re eligible: www.medicare.gov/ExtraHelp

Thanks to a new prescription drug law, many people will qualify for additional savings on their Medicare drug coverage (Part D) costs in 2024. Don’t wait – see if you qualify for “Extra Help” today at www.medicare.gov/ExtraHelp

If you make less than \$22,000 per year (\$30,000 for married couples), you may qualify for “Extra Help.” It could cut your Medicare Part D drug costs to no more than \$4.15 for generic prescriptions and \$10.35 for brand-name drug prescriptions. Apply online through Social Security at www.SSA.gov/ExtraHelp.
