Section 3004(a) and (b) of the Affordable Care Act established the Long-Term Care Hospital (LTCH) and Inpatient Rehabilitation Facility (IRF) Quality Reporting Programs (QRPs) respectively. CMS will publicly report IRF and LTCH quality performance data on the new IRF and LTCH Compare websites, beginning in late fall 2016. CMS will issue a Preview Report to each provider in order to give them the opportunity to review their quality data, prior to publicly posting the data. During this webinar, CMS will discuss the Preview Reports for IRFs and LTCHs that will be available to providers in the near future. Participants will gain an understanding of how to access these reports, how to interpret the contents of these reports, and what to do if they believe their report contains an error.
