


On August 22, 2006, the Kansas Health Policy Authority submitted a state plan amendment, transmittal #06-13, to establish a benchmark package for the TWWIIA Basic 1902(a)(10)(A)(ii)(XV) Working Healthy population. This amendment gives individuals with developmental disabilities access to personal assistance services.

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services has approved this amendment for the purposes of federal financial participation effective January 1, 2007. Approval of this state plan amendment is limited to the scope of the submitted benefit provision and does not constitute approval of any change in reimbursement methodologies, new reimbursement methodologies, or change in sources of non-Federal share funding utilized by the State to make such Medicaid payments.

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
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
