


Joining The Webinar



Accessing Data Guidance


- **Step 1:** Go to the CMS PQRS GPRO Web Interface website at http://www.cms.gov/Medicare/Quality-Initiatives-Patient-Assessment-Instruments/PQRS/GPRO_Web_Interface.html
- **Step 2:** Scroll to the bottom of the web page and select the *2013 Supporting Documents and Release Notes for ACO and PQRS GPRO Web Interface Users* hyperlink in the “Downloads” section
 - Your web browsers will then ask you if you want to open or save the zipped file




Accessing Data Guidance

- **Step 3:** Once the zipped file has opened, you will see an Excel workbook for each measure module. Select the applicable measure module, such as “2013_GPRO_CAD_SupportingDocuments_v4.2_May2013.xlsx” to review the CAD Data Guidance.

CAD will be used for this example



- **Step 4:** Once the Excel workbook has opened, go to the bottom of the worksheet and select the “CAD Data Guidance” tab

Submitting a Question

- WebEx interaction takes place in various panels on the right-hand side of the screen
- Chat Box: use this window to post technical questions or issues for troubleshooting support
 - Use the drop-down arrow to address your question/comment to the appropriate party (i.e. “Host”, “All Panelists”, etc.)
- Q&A Box: use this window to post questions related to the presentation or webinar topic
