2007 Re-Run and 2008 Physician Quality Reporting Initiative (PQRI) Feedback Reports User Guide V2.0

Changes to Table 1: Earned Incentive Summary for Taxpayer Identification Number (Tax ID) in the Feedback Report are outlined below.

The following was added to the footnotes column headings, Total # Measures with QDCs Submitted, Total # Measures Denominator Eligible with QDCs, Total # Measures Satisfactorily Reported

- If the reporting method is through measures groups, the field under the column headings will be populated with 'N/A'.

The following Note was added to the bottom of the footnotes:

- Note: Your actual payment may vary slightly from the amount listed in the "Total Tax ID Earned Incentive Amount for NPIs" column.

Changes to "Key Facts about PQRI Incentive Eligibility and Amount Calculation" are outlined below.

Under Incentive Payment Distribution, the following bullet point was added:

- The PQRI incentive payments are subject to offsets. Payments are made to the Tax ID (TIN) of the first PIN tied to that TIN. So if that initial PIN has an offset, carriers will apply the lump sum.

Under Frequent Concerns, the following bullet points were updated:

- The Electronic Remittance Advice sends only a 2-character code (LS – lump sum) will appear in PLB03-1 on the outgoing 835.
- PQRI feedback report availability is not based on whether or not an incentive payment was earned. Feedback reports will be available for every TIN under which at least one EP (identified by his or her NPI submitting Medicare Part B PFS claims) reported at least one valid PQRI measure a minimum of once during the reporting period.
