#### I. GENERAL INFORMATION

**A. Background:** VMS processes in a CICS environment. An inherent part of CICS is the ability to create "maps" of the data. These "maps," called Application Data Structure (ADS) Descriptors, allow other programs to read the CICS data without the need to constantly refer back to the actual copybooks. Some applications, such as MQ Series, require the existence of ADS Descriptors to perform the data reads.

As CICS coding is updated, a recompile of the affected modules should be performed. There are areas of VMS codes that have not been changed, and therefore, not been recompliled in some time. As a result, the necessary ADS Descriptors are not present.

**B. Policy:** Most of the data has been recompiled in a timely way to create ADS Descriptors. There are four maps that need recompiling. They are VMSBURO, VMSBU02, VMSFA08, and VMSFR02. Once the data has been recompiled, VMS shall pass the new load modules to the EDC to allow the EDC to refresh the current modules with the ones with the recompiled data.
