I. GENERAL INFORMATION

A. Background: HIGLAS, Part A 935, Part A and Part B HPSA, Part A-Other, and Part A-Provider RAC Identified debts with an original balance of less than \$25 are not demanded, as the threshold amount to generate a demand letter must equal \$25 or more for Part A and Part B debts.

HIGLAS currently does not systematically aggregate and demand these debts; however the debts remain open in HIGLAS and are available for offset and interest accrual. This current process conflicts with policy (Pub. 100-06, chapter 4, section 30.3, A) where interest should only accrue on debts that have been demanded.

B. Policy: Contractors currently on HIGLAS manually process and aggregate Part A 935 under tolerance debts. Instructions have been provided to the Contractors to assist with compliance. The instructions involve waiving finance charges, turning off AR/AP Netting flag, adjusting down the principal and interest transactions and creating a new aggregated transaction relating to under tolerance debt.

This CR provides instructions to automate this manual process within HIGLAS for the under tolerance Part A 935, Part A-Other, Part A and Part B HPSA, and Part A-Provider RAC Identified debts.
