## LEGAL NOTICE OF TERMINATION FROM MEDICARE PROGRAM

Effective on April 30, 2024, the Secretary of the Department of Health & Human Services will terminate its Medicaid Provider Agreement with Childrens Healthcare Organization of Northern California – (CHONC) Pediatric Hospital, located in Campbell, California. This action is being taken because this hospice agency is not in compliance with requirements for participation in the Medicare and Medicaid program as established by the Social Security Act (Section 1861) and its underlying regulations.

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services has determined that Childrens Healthcare Organization of Northern California–(CHONC) Pediatric Hospital, is not in compliance with the following Medicare Conditions of Participation for Hospice services:

42 CFR 482.1 Basis and Scope

Medicaid programs will not make payments for services furnished to patients who were admitted on or after April 30, 2024. For patients admitted prior to April 30, 2024, payment may be available for up to thirty (30) calendar days after the effective date of termination.
