<u>Technical Alert: Response File Naming Convention Change for Liability</u> <u>Insurance (Including Self-Insurance), No-Fault Insurance, and Workers'</u> <u>Compensation</u>

Effective April 6, 2015, CMS is modifying the naming convention used for the Claim Response, TIN Response and Query Response Files. In order to ensure filenames are always unique, the values of the time node will be changed.

Requirements

As of April 6, 2015, the "T" node of the response filename will be modified. The space previously occupied by 'sscc' (seconds and centiseconds) will be replaced with a number from 0000 to 9999. The length and format of the filename will remain the same. The revised naming convention is shown below:

Claim Response:PCOB.BA.MR.NGHPCLM.RESP.Dccyymmdd.Thhmm###.TXTTIN Response:PCOB.BA.MR.NGHPTIN.RESP.Dccyymmdd.Thhmm####.TXTQuery Response:PCOB.BA.MR.NGHPQRY.RESP.Dccyymmdd.Thhmm####.TXT
