#### I. GENERAL INFORMATION

### A. Background:

The Laboratory NCD Edit Software should be updated to accommodate the processing of ICD-10 diagnosis codes. This is a follow-up to CR7808/TR1071, dated April 26, 2012, that expanded the diagnosis files to 30 in the diagnosis code fields.

**B. Policy:** The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) requires that the Laboratory NCD Edit Software should be able to accommodate using ICD-10 diagnosis codes on claims for dates of service October 1, 2014, and after.

NOTE: The ICD-10 spreadsheet and mainframe filenames attached to this CR were delivered under separate cover to the maintaners on December 14 and 21 respectively - no changes have been made to the files since those dates.

8202.3	The ICD-9-CM table has termination dates of September 30, 2014, added and the ICD-10-CM table has effective start dates of October 1, 2014 added. Impact is that the transition date of 2014 is implemented so that transactions will be processed correctly. Currently, the ICD-9-CM table has the termination date of September 30, 2013, and the ICD-10-CM table has the effective start date of October 1, 2013, both of which will be updated.
8202.4	The indicator code is a flag that contains "9" which implies ICD-9-CM codes or "0" which implies ICD-10-CM codes. The impact is that a default table of ICD-9-CM will be used when blanks or other characters are in the indicator code. If the value of the indicator code is valid ("9" for ICD-9-CM or "0" for ICD-10-CM), the appropriate table will be used.
8202.8	The impact is that the ABEND codes will not happen due to storage issues when flipping between the ICD-9 and ICD-10 tables for claims processing. Cobol pointers will be used to point to the ICD-9 table or ICD-10 table, and will be re-assigned when the indicator code changes to flip between the tables
8202.5	The impact is that only dates within 2 years before and after the date of the Online Inquiry Session year will be processed. Other dates will get the "INVALID DATE ENTERED" error message.
8202.6	The impact of the RMODE=ANY option is that it will preserve the ICD-9 and ICD-10 tables in storage during claims processing and overwriting of the tables will not be allowed (tables are "read-only"). This option must be implemented with requirements .1 and .2.
8202.1	The impact of setting the RENT option is that it will preserve the ICD-9 and the ICD-10 tables in storage during claims processing and overwriting of the tables will not be allowed (tables are "read-only"). This option must be implemented with requirements .2 and .7.
8202.2	The impact of the AMODE=31 setting is that it will preserve the ICD-9 and the ICD-10 tables in storage during claims processing and overwriting of the tables will not be allowed (tables are "read-only"). This option must be implemented with requirements .1 and .7.
8202.7	The impact is that the service date will need to be valid for both ICD-9-CM and ICD-10-CM codes:  ICD-9-CM service dates must be after November 25, 2002, and before October 1, 2014; ICD-10-CM service start date must be at least October 1, 2014, or later. If not, then the following error message is received: "SERVICE DATE < 11/2001 OR > 10/1/2014" for ICD-9-CM or "SERVICE DATE < 10/1/2014" for ICD-10-CM.
