I. GENERAL INFORMATION

- **A. Background:** The Administrative Simplification provisions of the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 (HIPAA) mandate the adoption of a standard unique health identifier for each health care provider. The National Provider Identifier (NPI) final rule, published on January 23, 2004, establishes the NPI as this standard. All health care providers and entities covered under HIPAA must comply with the requirements of the NPI final rule (45 CFR Part 162, CMS- 0045-F).
- **B. Policy:** Effective May 23, 2008, the NPI replaced the UPIN as a unique identifier. This change request updates chapter 14, of Pub.100-08, Medicare Program Integrity Manual, by removing information related to the issuance and maintenance of UPIN and replacing this information with information about obtaining NPI and UPIN data.

Unique Physician Identification Number (UPIN) Data (Rev. 263; Issued: 07-25-08; Effective Date: 05-23-08; Implementation Date: 08-08-08)

With the implementation of the National Provider Identifier (NPI), the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) discontinued assigning UPINs in June 2007. Effective May 23, 2008, Medicare will use the NPI as both a primary and secondary identifier.

14.2 - Privacy Act Requirements

14.2.1 - *NPI*

(Rev. 263; Issued: 07-25-08; Effective Date: 05-23-08; Implementation Date: 08-08-08)

The CMS has established a Privacy Act system of records notice titled the "National Plan and Provider Enumeration System (NPPES)". The primary purpose of the notice is to collect information needed to uniquely identify individual/organizational health care providers, to assign an NPI to those health care providers, to maintain and update the information about the health care providers, and to disseminate health care provider information in accordance with the provisions of the Privacy Act of 1974. CMS published the NPPES Data Dissemination notice on May 30, 2007. In accordance with the e-FOIA Amendments, CMS has disclosed these data via the Internet.

14.2.2 - *UPIN*

(Rev. 263; Issued: 07-25-08; Effective Date: 05-23-08; Implementation Date: 08-08-08)

The CMS has established a Privacy Act system of records titled the "Unique Physician/Practitioner Identification Number (UPIN)". The information in the UPIN database is subject to the provisions of the Privacy Act. CMS published a system of records notice in the Federal Register on November 15, 2006. This notice specified the purpose for collecting the information maintained in this system and routine uses which permit disclosure without the prior written consent of the individual to whom the record pertains.

14.3 - Access to NPI Data

(Rev. 263; Issued: 07-25-08; Effective Date: 05-23-08; Implementation Date: 08-08-08)

Information about the NPI can be found at: (1) a query-only database, known as the NPI Registry at https://nppes.cms.hhs.gov/NPPES or (2) a NPPES downloadable file at http://nppesdata.cms.hhs.gov/cms NPI files.html

14.3.1 - *NPI Registry*

(Rev. 263; Issued: 07-25-08; Effective Date: 05-23-08; Implementation Date: 08-08-08)

The NPI registry allows users to perform simple queries to retrieve read-only information from NPPES. For example, users may search by the NPI or legal business name to locate the NPPES records and search for an individuals or organizations. The NPI Registry will return the results of the query to the user, and the user will click on the record(s) he/she wants to view.

14.3.2 - NPI Downloadable File

(Rev. 263; Issued: 07-25-08; Effective Date: 05-23-08; Implementation Date: 08-08-08)

The downloadable files contain the data for health care providers who have been assigned NPIs.

There is no charge to download the files containing the NPPES FOIA-disclosable health care provider data. User IDs and passwords are not needed to download these files.
