SUBJECT: Changes to the Laboratory National Coverage Determination (NCD) Edit Software for April 2006

I. GENERAL INFORMATION

- **A. Background:** This transmittal announces the changes that will be included in the April 2006 release of the edit module for clinical diagnostic laboratory services. The NCDs for clinical diagnostic laboratory services were developed by the laboratory negotiated rulemaking committee and published as a final rule on November 23, 2001. Nationally uniform software has been developed by Computer Sciences Corporation and incorporated in the shared systems so that laboratory claims subject to one of the 23 NCDs are processed uniformly throughout the nation effective January 1, 2003. The laboratory edit module for the NCDs will be updated quarterly as necessary to reflect ministerial coding updates and substantive changes to the NCDs developed through the NCD process. (See Pub.100-4, chapter 16 § 120.2.)
- **B. Policy:** In accordance with chapter 16, section §120.2, the laboratory edit module is updated quarterly. The changes are a result of coding analysis decisions developed under the procedures for maintenance of codes in the negotiated NCDs. Several of the listed changes correct codes to reflect the current CPT update. This instruction communicates requirements to shared system maintainers and contractors notifying them of changes to the laboratory edit module to update it for changes in laboratory NCD code lists for April 2006. Changes are being made to the NCD code lists as described below. These changes become effective for services furnished on or after April 1, 2006.
