Notice to Public of Termination of Viviant Healthcare of Shelbyville

The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) has determined that Viviant Healthcare of Shelbyville has failed to substantially comply with Medicare and Medicaid health and safety participation requirements. Notice is hereby given that on February 11, 2024, in compliance with federal law, CMS will terminate the Medicare provider agreement between the Secretary of Health and Human Services and Viviant Healthcare of Shelbyville, 1101 Glen Oaks Road, Shelbyville, Tennessee 37160.

Based on Denial of Payment for New Admissions imposed on Viviant Healthcare of Shelbyville in the CMS notices dated August 22, 2023, and December 22, 2023, CMS will not pay for skilled nursing facility services furnished to Medicare and Medicaid beneficiaries admitted to Viviant Healthcare of Shelbyville on or after November 11, 2023. CMS has been informed that all residents have been relocated as of December 21, 2023; therefore, no additional payment will be provided to Viviant Healthcare of Shelbyville after December 21, 2023.

We understand the relocation of residents can be challenging for all parties involved, CMS prioritizes resident safety and care quality. CMS monitored the relocation of Viviant Healthcare of Shelbyville residents, and all were successfully relocated to new homes of their choice as of December 21, 2023.
