


Tips on Preparation

- Prepare a presentation package that can be easily tailored
- Ensure you have an acceptable/audited or adequate accounting system
- Do your homework (learn about the organization before you market to them)
- Bring the right people to a meeting

Dynamic Small Business Search (DSBS)

Key Point: Small businesses can complete a corporate profile addressing:

- Business Type (8A, Hubzone, etc.)
- North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) (what types of work your business performs)
- Performance History (work your business has done in the past)



Performance History (References)



Include name of contracting entity, contact information, contract number, dollar value, period, etc. for current federal and commercial prime and subcontracts. Blanks leave too many questions for contracting officers. Always include references, even if subcontracting work performed.

• Attend Industry Days

• Reach out to business partners for teaming/subcontracting arrangements

Make Sure You:

- Understand and comply with FAR/HHSAR/Agencyspecific provisions/clauses/terms
- Understand and comply with auditing standards, FISMA standards, and other Federal requirements
- Understand the players and comply with the procurement rules to conduct business appropriate to the Federal Government
