

Massachusetts One Care

This contract was re-executed on December 28, 2015 in order to:

- Perform general clean-up and make technical changes to streamline provisions across all three-way contracts for the capitated model demonstrations under the Medicare-Medicaid Financial Alignment Initiative.
- Reflect current federal or state law or regulatory guidance, including:
 - Addition of gender identity to the list of protected categories.
 - Changes to Substance Use Disorder service requirements to reflect State Law (Chapter 258 of the Acts of 2014).
- Update the 2015 and 2016 financial parameters, including:
 - Increases to the Medicare and MassHealth base components of the capitated payment rates.
 - Changes to quality withhold percentages and measures, including adding the encounter data process measure as a quality withhold for demonstration years 2 and 3.
 - Changes to savings percentages.
- Incorporate two previous contract addenda into the main body of the contract.

This contract was further amended on July 5, 2016 in order to:

- Extend the demonstration an additional two years, through December 31, 2016.
- Include the financial parameters for 2017 and 2018 (savings percentages, quality withhold percentages, and risk corridor terms).
