

Texas Dual Eligible Integrated Care Demonstration Project

This contract was re-executed on December 15, 2015 in order to:

- Perform general clean-up and make technical changes to streamline provisions across all three-way contracts for the capitated model demonstrations under the Medicare-Medicaid Financial Alignment Initiative.
- Add the encounter data process measure as a quality withhold for demonstration years 2 and 3.
- Reflect current federal or state law or regulatory guidance and align with STAR+PLUS Medicaid managed care contracts, including:
 - Edits made to the STAR+PLUS contracts by the Texas Office of the Inspector General to conform to current fraud, waste, and abuse requirements.
 - Adding a new provision to clarify that the STAR+PLUS MMPs are responsible for paying providers for language services.
 - Changes to mirror STAR+PLUS Medicaid managed care contract changes to clarify requirements related to abuse, neglect, and exploitation and critical incident and event reporting that has been added to the state Medicaid managed care contract.
 - Changes made to reflect updates to the 2016 Medicare Marketing Guidance.
