Version 5010 refers to the standards that anyone covered by HIPAA must use when electronically conducting certain health care administrative transactions, such as claims, remittance, eligibility, and claims status requests and responses.

To be compliant, organizations must have upgraded to and begun using Version 5010 to send and receive claims and all other HIPAA adopted electronic transactions starting on January 1; however, CMS has implemented an

enforcement discretion period which is in effect now **until March 31, 2012.**
