Re: Notice of Release from Low Income Subsidy (LIS) Auto-Enrollment and Annual Reassignment Exclusion

Dear Mr. Meek:

Effective January 1, 2014, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (“CMS”) released the marketing and enrollment sanctions imposed on SilverScript Insurance Company (“SSIC”). Although SSIC was released from these intermediate sanctions, SSIC agreed to forgo receiving or processing LIS auto-enrollments and LIS reassignees until CMS could evaluate SSIC’s ability to administer the LIS benefit with actual enrollments.

Based on monitoring activities conducted January 1, 2014 through February 20, 2014, CMS has determined that SSIC demonstrated sufficient improvement in administering the LIS benefit to merit lifting the LIS auto-enrollment and reassignment exclusion. The exclusion was lifted February 21, 2014 and is effective immediately.

CMS will continue to monitor SSIC’s administration of the LIS benefit and expects SSIC to work closely with its Account Managers to address any future issues. If you have any questions about this notice, please call or email your CMS enforcement lead.
