The Effectiveness of Cochlear Implants in Adults with Sensorineural Hearing Loss report dated June 17, 2011 includes two minor corrections. The first correction occurs in Table 9, “Open-set sentences and multi-syllable tests in subjects with bilateral simultaneous cochlear implant,” under the Results column. The white down arrow (worse but no statistical significance) in reference to the Buss 2008 study has been revised to a white up arrow (benefit but no statistical significance) to match the text under Study Results section. The second correction occurs in Appendix E, References of Included Studies. The PubMed Identifier (PMID) for the following reference has been revised to reflect the correct PMID number: Verschuur et al. Auditory localization abilities in bilateral cochlear implant recipients. *Otology and Neurotology* 2005;26(5):965-71.

None of these minor corrections will have any impact on the findings of the assessment, as they were typographical errors; and the text under Study Results section truly represent data analysis and conclusion.
