08	<p>The pressure ulcer items at M0210 and M0300 do not include edits concerning the use of dash [-] values used when items are “Not assessed/no information”. For example, if a dash [-] is coded for item M0210_1 indicating that the number of pressure ulcers at admission was not assessed, then there is no restriction on the coding for M0300A1_1 (number of Stage 1 pressure ulcers at admission) and a value indicating 2 pressure ulcers can be coded for M0300A1_1. If an assessor has not assessed whether pressure ulcers were present (M0210_1) then it is inconsistent to report 2 Stage 1 pressure ulcers.
