In September 2011, 35 medical practice groups, each with at least 200 affiliated physicians received group-level confidential feedback reports, also known as Quality and Resource Use Reports (QRURs). The groups chose to participate in the CMS Physician Quality Reporting System Group Reporting Option 1 (GPRO-1) during 2010 and shared a single tax identification number (TIN).
