

# Quick Reference Guide for Accessing the 2014 Mid-Year QRURs and Supplementary Exhibits

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## I. Introduction

In **April 2015**, CMS made available the 2014 Mid-Year Quality and Resource Use Reports (QRURs) to every physician group practice with two or more eligible professionals (EPs) and physician solo practitioners nationwide. Although the 2016 Value Modifier (VM) will not apply to physician solo practitioners, physician groups with fewer than ten EPs, or groups with at least one physician who participated in the Shared Savings Program, Pioneer ACO Model, or Comprehensive Primary Care (CPC) Initiative in 2014, CMS made Mid-Year QRURs available to these groups and physician solo practitioners for informational purposes.

The performance period for 2014 Mid-Year QRUR is July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2014. The 2014 Mid-Year QRUR is based on the CY2014 Medicare Physician Fee Schedule Final Rule (2016 Value-Based Payment Modifier [VM] policies). Mid-Year QRURs do not include all of the measures described in the Final Rule; specifically, only exhibits with measures that can be computed via claims are included. The following measures and VM-specific calculations that are discussed in the CY2014 Final Rule are **not** included in the Mid-Year QRURs:

- a. GPRO and Individual Eligible Professional Physician Quality Reporting System (PQRS) Measures (including CAHPS)
- b. Calculations related to the VM, including, cost and quality composite scores, quality and cost performance categories (High, Average, Low), and the quality tiering categories.

This Quick Reference Guide illustrates how to access and download a 2014 Mid-Year QRUR, along with the supplemental exhibits from the CMS Enterprise Portal. 2014 Mid-Year QRURs (including a 508 compliant version) and supplemental exhibits can be downloaded and exported in PDF or Excel Format. The data in the 2014 Mid-Year QRURs is also available for download to an exportable comma-separated values (CSV) file.

## II. Getting Started

Authorized representatives of groups and solo practitioners can access the 2014 Mid-Year QRURs at <https://portal.cms.gov> using an Individuals Authorized Access to the CMS Computer Services (IACS) account with one of the following Physician Value (PV)-PQRS System roles:

- **For a group with 2 or more EPs (TIN with 2 or more National Provider Identifiers (NPIs) that bill under the TIN):**
  - PV-PQRS Group Security Official (primary or back-up)
  - PV-PQRS Group Representative
- **For a solo practitioner (TIN with only 1 NPI that bills under the TIN):**
  - PV-PQRS Individual (primary or back-up)
  - PV-PQRS Individual Representative



