Subject: State-to-Plan Reconciliation: Testing Update and Revised Timeline

This letter is intended to provide Part D Plan Sponsors (and their PBM/Processors) with updated information on State-to-Plan Reconciliation testing and to provide a revised production timeline.

As of February 13th a total of eight PBMs covering 245 of the 670 Part D contracts have received test files from PCG. As some modifications from the standard were required in order to receive the intended data from the states, PCG is now in the process of mapping the non-standard data to the standard NCPCP 1.1 and 5.1 formats. As a result of the initial test files, many PBMs have provided meaningful feedback as to field and format changes required for their systems. Many of these changes identified by the original eight PBMs affect all test files. Therefore, PCG has stopped the release of test files until these changes can be made. This delay is necessary but will result in more manageable data in future test files.

Originally, all tests and the signing of the Attestation of System Readiness document were to be completed by February 15, 2007. Due to various delays in the process, we are extending that deadline to March 15, 2007 for completion of the test process.

In addition, to date, no PBMs have claimed 121 Part D contract numbers as their responsibility for processing the claims received. A listing of these contract numbers and their names are provided at the end of this document. Please review this list carefully for the name of your PDP. If any of your contracts are still on this list, please immediately follow the instructions below:

Plan Sponsors:

- 1. Contact your PBM/processor and provide all PDP plan codes (H codes and S codes) for all covered plans, and/or
- 2. Contact your PBM/processor and ask them to contact Nicole Lisk (nlisk@pcgus.com) on your behalf, and
- 3. Ensure your PBM/processor has the instructions listed below:

Note: CMS and PCG are requesting that when possible all communication and collaboration with PCG be facilitated through each Part D plan's processor/PBM since the volume of requests from individual PDPs is further delaying the process of finalizing testing these claims in a timely manner.

PBMs/Processors:

- 1. Modify your claims processing system. Configure your system to identify the value "MEDDSTTOPY" in the NCPDP field 110-AK: *Software Vendor/Certification ID* to indicate the special Medicare Part D reconciliation process, thus avoiding a duplicate reimbursement to the pharmacy.
- 2. Provide PCG with the following information:
 - Contact person and contact information.
 - Preference for claims submission: NCPDP 1.1 (batch) or 5.1 (real-time) format.
 - Earliest date of availability to receive a test file for claims submission.
- 3. Provide PCG with all the plan names and all corresponding H-codes (and S-codes) that your PBM covers.
