



Medicare and Medicaid Notice to the Public

Notice is hereby given that on June 6, 2019 the agreement between the Secretary of Health and Human Services and Hallmark Living Holland, Holland, MI as a skilled nursing facility in the Medicare program will be terminated.

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services has determined that Hallmark Living Holland has failed to attain substantial compliance with the following Medicare and Medicaid participation requirements:

- 42 CFR 483.10 Resident Rights
- 42 CFR 483.12 Freedom from Abuse, Neglect and Exploitation
- 42 CFR 483.20 Resident Assessments
- 42 CFR 483.21 Comprehensive Care Plans
- 42 CFR 483.24 Quality of Life
- 42 CFR 483.25 Quality of Care
- 42 CFR 483.30 Physicians Services
- 42 CFR 483.35 Nursing Services
- 42 CFR 482.45 Pharmacy Services
- 42 CFR 482.60 Food and Nutrition Services
- 42 CFR 483.90 Physical Environment

The Medicare program will not make payment for skilled nursing facility services furnished to residents admitted to the facility on or after March 6, 2019. For residents admitted prior to March 6, 2019, payment may continue to be made for up to 30 days of services after June 6, 2019, the date of termination.

In addition, Federal Financial Participation will not be available to the State for any Medicaid residents admitted to the facility on or after March 6, 2019. For Medicaid residents admitted prior to March 6, 2019, Federal Financial Participation may continue to be made to the State for up to 30 days of covered services to qualified residents furnished on or after June 6, 2019, the date of termination.
