



# 2009 Electronic Prescribing (E-Prescribing)

Incentive Program Made Simple Quick Reference Chart

Before you report the e-prescribing measure, you should ask yourself the following questions:

## QUESTION 1:

Do you have an e-prescribing system/program and are you **routinely** using it?

## QUESTION 2:

Is your system capable of doing the functions of a qualified system?

## QUESTION 3:

Do you expect your Medicare Part B Fee-for-Service (FFS) charges for the codes (90801, 90802, 90804, 90805, 90806, 90807, 90808, 90809, 92002, 92004, 92012, 92014, 96150, 96151, 96152, 99201, 99202, 99203, 99204, 99205, 99211, 99212, 99213, 99214, 99215, 99241, 99242, 99243, 99244, 99245, G0101, G0108, G0109) in the denominator of the measure to make up at least 10% of your total Medicare Part B FFS allowed charges for 2009?

**If the answer to all three questions is YES,**

You may be eligible for the incentive payment. You should report the e-prescribing measure.

**If the answer to the first two questions is YES but the answer to the third question is NO,**

You may not be eligible for the incentive payment. However, we encourage you to report the measure. In the event that your Medicare Part B FFS charges for the codes in the denominator of the measure do make up at least 10% of your total Medicare Part B FFS allowed charges for 2009, you may be eligible for the incentive payment.

**If the answer to either of the first two questions is NO,**

You cannot report this measure unless you obtain and use a qualified e-prescribing system.



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
