The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) has contracted with CORE to develop a patient-reported outcome performance measure (PRO-PM) for patients undergoing non-emergent percutaneous coronary intervention (PCI). The contract name is Development, Reevaluation, and Implementation of Hospital Outcome/Efficiency Measures, Option Year 2. The contract number is HHSM-500-2013-13018I- T0001. As part of its measure development process, CMS asks contractors to convene groups of stakeholders and experts who contribute direction and thoughtful input to the measure contractor during measure development and maintenance. The following individuals were selected and have agreed to serve as the Technical Expert Panel for this project.
