Project Overview:

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) has contracted with Yale New Haven Health Services Corporation/Center for Outcomes Research and Evaluation (CORE) to develop a hospital-level outcome performance measure of all-cause mortality across a broad mix of medical and surgical patients admitted to the hospital. The intent is to create a measure that can be used to assess hospital-level performance measurement for Medicare fee-for-service (FFS) patients. The overarching purpose of the project is to develop a measure that can be used to enhance the quality of care provided to Medicare beneficiaries. The contract name is Development, Reevaluation, and Implementation of Hospital Outcome/Efficiency Measures, Option Year 2; the contract number is Contract Number: HHSM-500-2013-13018I, Task Order HHSM-500-T0001. As part of its measure development process, CMS asks contractors to convene groups of stakeholders and experts who contribute direction and thoughtful input to the measure contractor during measure development and maintenance.
