

2013 GPRO Web Interface Pre-filled Elements 02/11/2014

There are several measures for which pre-filled elements are populated in the Web Interface (WI) when found in the beneficiary claims analysis. The analysis looks at all claims submitted for the beneficiary regardless of where the services were rendered. The claims analysis begins at the end of October 2013; therefore not all of the beneficiary information may be pre-populated for the performance year.

Measures Requiring Additional Information from GPROs

- **DM-2 and DM-15** – If the HbA1c test was performed and can be found, it is pre-filled with a “Yes” in the WI to indicate the test was performed and the date of the test. The GPRO must add the value. In addition, if there is a more recent HbA1c test found in the patient record, the GPRO must utilize the more recent data and result when completing the measure.
- **DM-14** – If the LDL-C was performed and can be found, it is pre-filled with a “Yes” in the WI to indicate the test was performed and the date of test. The GPRO must add the value. In addition, if there is a more recent LDL-C test found in the patient record, the GPRO must utilize the more recent data and result when completing the measure.
- **IVD-1** – If the lipid profile was performed and can be found, it is pre-filled with a “Yes” in the WI to indicate the Lipid Profile was performed and the date of test. The GPRO must add the LDL-C value. In addition, if there is a more recent lipid profile test found in the patient record, the GPRO must utilize the more recent data and result when completing the measure.

For DM-2, DM-5, DM-14 and IVD-1: If a value for the pre-filled date or more recent test cannot be found in the patient record, the pre-filled date may be replaced with the most recent date of the test found in the medical record within the measurement period. If the GPRO cannot find any test within this allotted period, leave the “Yes” and use a zero for the value within the Web Interface.

- **PREV-5** – If the mammogram was performed and can be found in claims, it is pre-filled with a “Yes” in the WI. The GPRO needs to review the medical record to confirm the date and the result of the mammography are recorded. If the GPRO cannot find a date and result of a mammogram within the measurement period or the year prior to the measurement period, the “Yes” should be changed to a “No.”
- **CARE-1** – Discharge date(s) will be pre-filled in the WI when a follow-up visit (within 30 days) is found. Discharge dates may not be edited by the GPRO. The GPRO must confirm patient discharge date(s) are as listed in the Web Interface + or - 2 days. Additionally, the GPRO must determine if the patient was seen within 30 days following the discharge(s) and if so, must also determine whether or not the discharge medications were reconciled with the most current medication list in the outpatient medical record.

Measures **NOT** Requiring Additional Information from GPROs

- **PREV-6** – If the colorectal cancer screening was performed and can be found, it is pre-filled with “Yes” in the WI. The GPRO doesn’t need to add or verify any additional information.
- **PREV-7** – If the influenza immunization was received and can be found, it is pre-filled with a “Yes” in the WI. The GPRO doesn’t need to add or verify any additional information.
- **PREV-8** – If the pneumococcal vaccination was received and can be found, it is pre-filled with a “Yes” in the WI. The GPRO doesn’t need to add or verify any additional information.
