

CMS PQRS Listserv Message: EIDM Remote Identity Proofing Multi-Factor Authentication Requirement

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) would like to remind Physician Quality Reporting System (PQRS) participants and their staff of an important system update scheduled to be in place on Monday, July 13, 2015.

The Individuals Authorized Access to CMS Computer Services (IACS) system will be retired, but current IACS user accounts will transition to an existing CMS system called Enterprise Identity Management (EIDM). The EIDM system provides a way for business partners to apply for, obtain approval of, and receive a single user ID for accessing multiple CMS applications.

Part of this transition is the adoption of Remote Identity Proofing (RIDP) and Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) services. This transition will help improve CMS' ability to reduce fraud and ensure system security.
