

## Provider Specialty Report 2nd Quarter 2010 Physician Quality Reporting Initiative

Report Date: 09/20/2010

This summary is provided to assist eligible professionals and their staff in interpreting the Provider Specialty Report. Please note that this report is based on the number of valid quality-data codes (QDCs) submitted by specialty and reasons why a submission is considered invalid. This report also includes lists of specialties reporting at least one valid QDC for each measure. This report does not include the number of claims for which an expected QDC was not submitted on an eligible claim.

### **Column Definitions for Quality-Data Code (QDC) Submission Error Report by Specialty:**

- Total QDCs Reported - Number of QDC submissions for a measure whether or not the QDC submission was valid and appropriate for a measure.
- Total Valid QDCs Reported - Number of valid and appropriate QDC submissions for a measure.
- Total QDCs Reported on Eligible Cases – Number of valid or invalid QDCs reported on eligible cases meeting the measure's denominator criteria.
- Patient Age Mismatch - Patient did not meet age requirements for the measure.
- Incorrect HCPCS - Incorrect HCPCS code for the measure - Patient claim did not meet denominator eligibility per measure specifications.
- Incorrect Diagnosis - Incorrect diagnosis code on claim - Patient claim did not meet denominator eligibility per measure specifications.
- Incorrect Diagnosis and HCPCS - Combination of incorrect HCPCS code and incorrect diagnosis code on claim - Patient claim did not meet
- Only QDC on Claim - Patient claim missing a qualifying denominator code (all line items contained only QDCs).
- Only QDC and Incorrect Diagnosis - Combination of missing qualifying denominator code and qualifying diagnosis code on the claim.
- Resubmitted QDCs - Submissions invalid due to resubmission of claims simply for the purpose of adding QDCs.

### **How to Read the Quality-Data Code Submission Error Report by Specialty:**

Using the Specialty of Allergy/Immunologists as an example, we find the following information as we read across each column: 22,401 QDC submissions were received for measures reported by this specialty, 19,499 of which were considered valid. Therefore, the Valid Submission Rate is 87.05%. The rest of the columns explain reasons for invalid submissions for measures reported by this specialty. We see that 1,471 (6.57%) submissions did not match the measure's age parameters; 5 (0.02%) submissions did not match the measure's gender parameters; 636 (2.84%) submissions were for patient encounters that are not listed in the denominator of the measures; 475 (2.12%) submissions were for patient diagnoses that are not listed in the denominator of the measures; 1,258 (5.62%) submissions were for both the patient encounters and diagnoses that are not listed in the denominator of the measures; 139 (0.62%) submissions showed only the numerator component (QDCs) on the claim and the denominator component (HCPCS) were not on the claim nor on any other related claim for the same beneficiary, date-of-service, NPI/TIN; 100 (0.45%) submissions showed only the numerator component (QDCs) on the claim and the diagnosis code on the claim is not listed in the denominator of the measures. There were no QDC resubmissions for this measure. There were also no submissions which lacked an NPI in the rendering provider ID field on the claim.

**Analysis Findings Include:****Quality Data Code (QDC) Submission Error Report by Specialty**

1. The specialties with the highest percentages of Valid QDCs Reported were:

Nuclear Medicine (95.80%),  
Oncology/Hematology (95.69%),  
Audiologist (95.58%),  
Chiropractor (95.04%), and  
Cardiology (94.53%).

2. Physicians had a higher rate of Valid QDC submissions (81.62%) than Non-physician providers (75.01%).

3. The highest rates of QDCs Only on a claim were among

OB/Gynecology (3.95%),  
Hand Surgery (2.88%),  
Psychiatry (2.76%),  
Dietitian/Nutritionist (1.91%), and  
Radiation Oncology (1.77%).

**Specialties Submitting Valid QDCs by Measure**

1. The specialties submitting valid QDCs on each measure are displayed. Four measures were reported by only one specialty: #65 URI: Appropriate Treatment for Children (Family Practice), #66 Appropriate Testing for Children with Pharyngitis(Pediatrics), #182: Functional Outcome Assessment in Chiropractic Care (Chiropractor) and #188 Referral for Otologic Evaluation for Patients with Congenital or Traumatic Deformity of the Ear (Otolaryngology).

**Explanatory Note:** The National Plan and Provider Enumeration System (NPPES) and the Health Care Provider Taxonomy codes were utilized as a reference for the specialties indicated in this report. The Health Care Provider Taxonomy captures specialty information in categories detailed enough to support credentialing information but also broad enough to support directory level specialization information. These codes are self-selected by the provider when input into NPPES and therefore this report is dependent on the codes the providers have used to identify themselves. There may be cases where multiple specialties applied to a provider but for purposes of this report only the first listed code from the NPPES database was utilized.

**Please note:** Modifications were made to the analytic code that identifies and selects qualifying HCPCS codes for some of the procedure-type measures. The counts of Reporting Denominator and Valid QDCs Reported for those measures may have decreased from the 1st quarter reports to the 2nd quarter reports. The measures affected were numbers 10, 21, 22, 99, 100, 146, 157, 172, and 185.
