

2009 Physician Quality Reporting System - Top 5 Measures Submitted By Specialty
Date: September 17, 2010

The purpose of this report is to provide information on the measures most frequently submitted by each specialty type.

Note: This report includes data for services rendered in CY 2009 and processed into NCH by February 26, 2010.

- The most commonly submitted measure for Physician providers was #57: Community-Acquired Pneumonia (CAP): Assessment of Oxygen Saturation with 21.95% of participating physicians reporting the measure, followed by Measure #54: 12-Lead Electrocardiogram (ECG) Performed for Non-Traumatic Chest Pain (21.83%), Measure #55: 12-Lead Electrocardiogram (ECG) Performed for Syncope (20.28%), Measure #56: Community-Acquired Pneumonia (CAP): Vital Signs (20.24%), and Measure #58: Community-Acquired Pneumonia (CAP): Assessment of Mental Status (19.24%).
- The most commonly submitted measures for Non-Physician providers were: #30: Perioperative Care: Timing of Prophylactic Antibiotics – Administering Physician (29.92%), #124: Health Information Technology (HIT): Adoption/Use of Electronic Health Records (16.45%), #54: 12-Lead Electrocardiogram (ECG) Performed for Non-Traumatic Chest Pain (13.11%), #154: Falls: Risk Assessment (13.05%), and #130: Documentation and Verification of Current Medications in the Medical Record (12.58%).
- Measure #124: Health Information Technology (HIT): Adoption/Use of Electronic Health Records was the most often commonly submitted measure for 16 different provider specialties.
- Across all provider specialties, Measure #54: 12-Lead Electrocardiogram (ECG) Performed for Non-Traumatic Chest Pain was the most commonly submitted measure, with 19.46% of all participating providers submitting this measure.
