


8th SOW Solo Practice Count Process Flow



Notes:

An individual UPIN may be active in more than one state.

'PCP' for this purpose is defined as individual UPINs actively practicing under specialty code 01 (General Practice), 08 (Family Practice) or 11 (Internal Medicine).


'Active' is determined by looking at all the setting records for each UPIN. If any of a given UPIN's settings are flagged as active the overall UPIN is considered active.

Some individual UPINs are flagged as being in group practice (phys_group_practice = '1') but do not have a corresponding member UPIN values in the Group UPIN Registry data. In these cases the UPINs are deemed "unknown" and are not included in the solo counts.

Active Solo UPINs can also appear as member in Group UPIN practice counts

Notes:

In order for the group to be considered 'Active', both the overall group and at least one individual member had to be active based on the registry indicator flags noted above

'PCP' for this purpose is defined as individual UPINs actively practicing within the group under specialty code 01 (General Practice), 08 (Family Practice) or 11 (Internal Medicine).

Non-PCP group practices are included as long as *at least 50%* of active individual members are PCP

Active PCP members of a Group Practice can also appear in the solo practice counts
