

2015 non-PQRS QCDR Measures Available for Public Reporting in late 2016

Overview

If you reported any of the following 2015 quality measures as part of a listed Qualified Clinical Data Register (QCDR), your performance scores may be publicly reported in late 2016.

QCDRs may elect to publicly report their non-Physician Quality Reporting System (PQRS) measures on Physician Compare profile pages or on their own website. All publicly reported measures will be included in the Downloadable Database available at Data.Medicare.gov. Starting on October 12, clinicians will be able to preview their performance scores as they will appear on Physician Compare for 30 days.
