## Physician Compare PY 2016 Clinician Downloadable Database Measures Available for Preview

## Overview

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) provides <u>official datasets</u> for the Medicare.gov <u>Physician Compare website</u> to give you useful information about groups, physicians, and other clinicians currently enrolled in Medicare and what they're doing to improve the care they provide.

Below is a list of the 2016 <u>Physician Quality Reporting System (PQRS) clinician-level measures</u> targeted for public reporting in the <u>Physician Compare Downloadable Database</u>. The Downloadable Database will include the performance information finalized in the 2016 Physician Fee Schedule final rule (80 FR 71125). All clinician-level PQRS measures will be publicly reported in the Downloadable Database as a percent.

Starting on October 18, 2017, clinicians will be able to preview their performance scores as they will appear on Physician Compare for 30 days. The secured measure preview will be facilitated through the <a href="PQRS">PQRS</a> <a href="PQRS">Portal</a>—Provider Quality Information Portal (PQIP).
