

Physician Compare PY 2016 Non-PQRS QCDR Measures Available for Preview

Overview

If you reported any of the following 2016 quality measures as part of a listed Qualified Clinical Data Register (QCDR), your performance scores may be publicly reported in late 2017 per the 2016 Physician Fee Schedule final rule (80 FR 71125 through 71126). QCDRs may elect to publicly report their non-Physician Quality Reporting System (PQRS) measures on [Physician Compare](#) profile pages or on their own website. All publicly reported measures will be included in the Downloadable Database available at Data.Medicare.gov. Non-PQRS QCDR measures will be reported as a percent on Physician Compare profile pages and in the Downloadable Database.
