



At the Native American Health center we provide many health care services to keep your children healthy. If your children do not have health insurance, please consider enrolling them into Medi-Cal or Healthy Families through our CHIPRA Outreach Team.

Native American children are greater than three times more likely to be uninsured than non-native children-the highest among all minority groups.



Children who have health insurance generally have better health throughout their childhood and into their teens. They are sick less often, get the treatment they need when they are not feeling well and are less likely to miss school due to illness.

So you have an appointment? Great, please bring the following:

- ◆ Proof of income for the current month
- ◆ Social security card and residency card
- ◆ Original or certified copies of citizenship documentation
- ◆ Original or certified copies of identity documentation for applicants 18 and older
- ◆ Self-employment income records
- ◆ Proof of American Indian/Alaska Native status
- ◆ Proof of pregnancy
- ◆ Bank statements



Children's health insurance covers regular routine care as well as urgent care including:

- ◆ Regular Check-Ups
- ◆ Prescription Drugs
- ◆ Immunizations
- ◆ Dental Care
- ◆ Emergency Care Services

Added Benefit for Native American/Alaskan Native applicants:

Families who can provide proof of parent or child's tribal enrollment may not have to pay premiums or co-pays when eligible for Healthy Families.
