President Obama signed legislation that added a lot of new funding for the Medicaid and Children's Health Insurance Programs, with a special focus on enrolling kids that are eligible but have not signed up for coverage.

By enrolling in a children's health insurance program you benefit your tribal community by maximizing health care resources. Lets **ALL** pull together for our children's health care.

Check...to see what health insurance is available for your child. Call Lummi Tribal Health Center at 384-0464 Ext. 2245. Thousands of families are eligible for health insurance coverage and don't even know it. Even if you've been turned down in the past, your child may be eligible now.

Protect...your child with regular check-ups, dental care, immunizations and prescription drugs, which are available to children enrolled in a children's health insurance program. You'll also gain peace of mind knowing you have coverage when you need it.

Expect...to re-enroll every year. Keeping your coverage means keeping your child healthy, but you have to renew yearly. Be ready to renew when your State office contacts you.
