## *Applying for Health Insurance is Easy and Confidential*

*Your child or teen may qualify for no-cost or low-cost health insurance coverage through Medicaid, the Child Health Plan + (CHP+) or the Colorado Indigent Care Program (CICP)*

*Many parents may also be eligible, even if you have a job and employer provided insurance.*

*If you or someone in your family needs health coverage, you should apply. To find information about these programs call or stop by the Denver Indian Health & Family Services clinic to enroll or get a free determination if you qualify for these great health care programs.*

*These programs typically cover a range of benefits including:*

- Doctor Visits
- Emergency Care
- Hospital Care
- Vaccinations
- Prescription Drugs
- Vision
- Hearing
- Dental
