Dear Tribal Leader:

On February 4, 2014, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) posted to its website a proposed 2015 Letter to Health Insurance Issuers who plan to offer Qualified Health Plans (QHPs) in a Federally-facilitated Marketplace (FFM) and the Federally-facilitated Small Business Health Options Program (FF-SHOP) for the 2015 plan year. The letter provides technical and operational guidance to the Health Insurance Issuers.

The letter references the model QHP Addendum for Indian Providers and Tribal Sponsorship of Premiums. While our proposed policy approach on these two issues remains unchanged from the 2014 letter to Issuers, we welcome your input and will fully consider any comments received on these and other topics addressed in the letter, both for the 2015 plan year as well as for future policy development.


