



# A New Path to Health Care for Indian Country

Many American Indians and Alaska Natives now qualify for free or low-cost health insurance through Medicaid, the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) and the New Health Insurance Marketplace. You may be wondering if you should sign up for the Marketplace. The answer is yes, because with health insurance you can go to any hospital or doctor that accepts your plan. You can still get treatment if your local clinic runs short of contract health service funds.

American Indian and Alaska Native families can now get no- or low-cost coverage more easily than ever before. Enrolling is private and easy, and it expands the coverage you get from Indian health programs.
