CDT Copyright Notice and Copyright Guidance

Required CDT Copyright Notice

On first appearance of CDT in a product or Internet posting affix the copyright notice specified below.

Copyright Year Guideline: The ADA copyright year is one year earlier than the year of the CDT codebook. For example, use copyright year 2021 for CDT codes contained in the ADA's 2022 codebook.

ADA Guidelines for CDT usage:

Hardcopy Publications: The ADA Copyright Notice shall appear on products and publications when CDT codes are referenced in the product.

Internet Publications: The ADA Copyright Notice shall appear on products and publications prior to the initial appearance of the CDT codes used in the product. The ADA requires use of a Point-and-Click License Agreement. (See ADA Exhibit 4 listed in the ADA CDT Exhibits Directory.)
