# Quarterly Update to Correct Coding Initiative (CCI) Edits, Version 12.3, Effective October 1, 2006

# **Provider Types Affected**

Physicians billing Medicare carriers

# Background

This article and related CR 5258 provide a reminder for physicians to take note of the quarterly updates to the coding initiatives. The next round of CCI edits will be effective on October 1, 2006. Physicians may view the current CCI edits and the current Mutually Exclusive Code (MEC) edits at <a href="http://www.cms.gov/Medicare/Coding/NationalCorrectCodInitEd/index.html">http://www.cms.gov/Medicare/Coding/NationalCorrectCodInitEd/index.html</a> on the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) website. The website will be updated with the Version 12.3 edits as soon as they are effective.

# **Key Points**

The National Correct Coding Initiative developed by CMS helps promote national correct coding methodologies and controls improper coding. The coding policies developed are based on coding conventions defined in the American Medical

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Association's Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) manual, national and local policies and edits, coding guidelines developed by national societies, analysis of standard medical and surgical practice, and review of current coding practice. The latest package of CCI edits, Version 12.3, is effective on October 1, 2006. This version will include all previous versions and updates from January 1, 1996 to the present and will be organized in two tables:

- Column 1/Column 2 Correct Coding Edits table; and
- MEC Edits table.
