Looking for a way to access certain Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) provider Internet applications? We established Individuals Authorized Access to CMS Computer Services (IACS) to enable our Business Partners to apply for and receive a single User ID to access many CMS applications, including Physician Quality Reporting feedback reports. Follow these steps to register:

- If you have not billed Medicare in more than a year, or you have not updated your enrollment record with your designated Medicare Contractor since November 2003, you will need to complete the Medicare enrollment application (Form CMS-855 or the Internet-based Provider Enrollment, Chain and Ownership System [PECOS] enrollment application) to obtain your IACS User ID and password.
