The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services will host a Special Open Door Forum (SODF) call with patient advocacy groups, dialysis patients, and other interested parties to provide information and to solicit feedback on the introduction of star ratings on Dialysis Facility Compare.

Dialysis Facility Compare (DFC) has become a major information resource for the end stage renal disease (ESRD) community. Originally launched in 2001 and mandated by the Balanced Budget Act of 1997, it currently features 9 measures on approximately 6,000 Medicare-certified dialysis facilities. To make it easier for consumers to compare and select providers, CMS introduced star ratings on DFC as part of our plan to feature star ratings on all of our Compare websites, including Nursing Home Compare and Physician Compare, which already have them. This Special Open Door Forum will provide background on the Compare website star rating initiative, the development of star ratings for DFC, and the role of star ratings and other important consumer information in making treatment decisions.
