The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) invites you to join a 60-minute national teleconference about the hospital-acquired condition (HAC) measures adopted for the Hospital Inpatient Quality Reporting Program (Reporting Program).

The purpose of the teleconference is to:

- Provide background and overview of the HAC measures and their adoption for the Reporting Program
- Describe the methodology used to calculate the HAC measures
- Show national results for the HAC measures
- Discuss how hospitals can use their Hospital-Specific Reports (HSRs)
- Answer hospitals' questions about the methodology used to calculate the HAC measures and the HAC measure HSRs.

Please note that this call will not address the adoption of the HAC measures under the Hospital Value-Based Purchasing program or under Section 3008 of the Affordable Care Act. This agenda is subject to change.
