

Introduction to the Fox Non-LIS Re-assignment Notice

What Is the Purpose of This Notice?

The notice is a follow-up to the Fox Re-assignment notice 11460, and informs people who had Medicare prescription drug coverage with Fox Insurance Company that they're being enrolled in a new Medicare prescription drug plan. Coverage in the new plan begins on June 1, 2010.

The notice is one page on white paper.

Who Gets This Notice?

Medicare is sending this notice to people who don't qualify for Extra Help and had Medicare prescription drug coverage with Fox Insurance Company.

When Do People Get This Notice?

The notice will be mailed in May 2010.

What Should People Do Next?

People don't need to do anything for Medicare to enroll them in a new plan. But, they can choose and join a different plan anytime before June 30, 2010. People who have questions about their Medicare prescription drug coverage options can do the following:

- Visit www.medicare.gov and get personalized drug plan information.
- Call 1-800-MEDICARE (1-800-633-4227). TTY users should call 1-877-486-2048.
- Call their State Health Insurance Assistance Program (SHIP) for free personalized health insurance counseling. See the "Medicare & You" handbook or call 1-800-MEDICARE for the telephone number for their state.

A few weeks ago, you got a notice from Medicare letting you know that Fox Insurance Company is no longer in the Medicare Program.
