**MODEL FORM FOR CERTIFICATION OF CHIROPRACTORS WHERE
REQUIREMENTS AFTER JUNE 30, 1974 APPLY**

I certify that the persons listed below meet the following Medicare qualifications as Chiropractors:

1. Preliminary education equal to the requirements for graduation from an accredited high school or other secondary school, and satisfactory completion of 2 years of prechiropractic study at the college level; and
2. Graduation from a college of chiropractic approved by the State chiropractic examiners with completion of a course of study covering a period of not less than 4 school years of 8 months each year in actual continuous attendance. The course of study included not less than 4,000 hours in the subjects of anatomy, physiology, symptomatology and diagnosis, hygiene and sanitation, chemistry, histology, pathology, principles and practice of chiropractic, including clinical instruction in vertebral palpation, nerve tracing and adjusting, plus courses in the use and effect of x-ray and chiropractic analysis; and
3. Passage of an examination prescribed by the State's chiropractic examiners covering the subjects listed in 2 above; and
4. The practitioners are over 21 years of age.
